I hope you all enjoy the 1985 ECHO. I, for one, will never forget it.

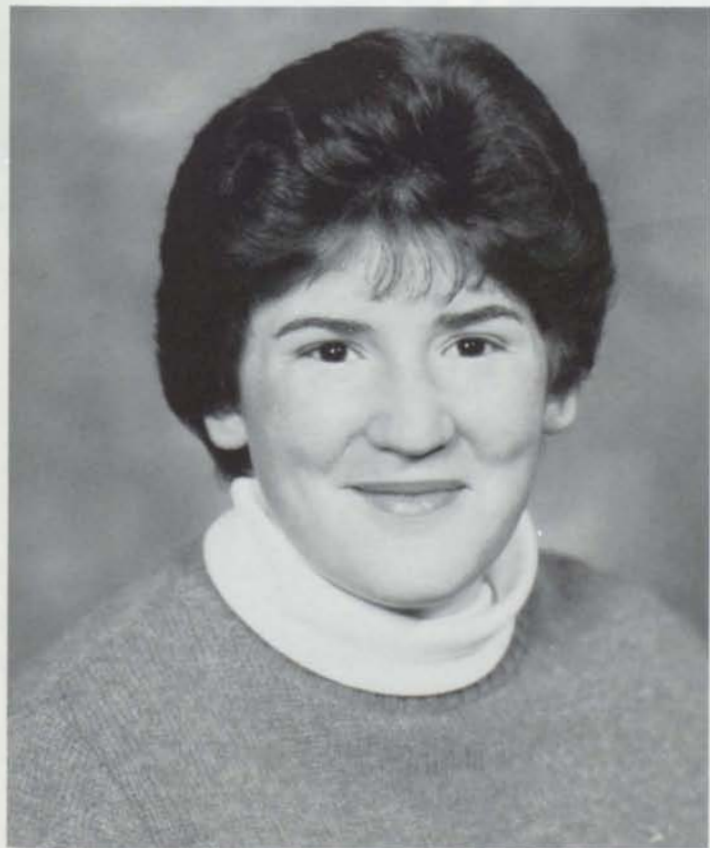
