Our stay at the castle was the most fun because we met a lot of people our own age and we had freedom. We all learned to live on our own.

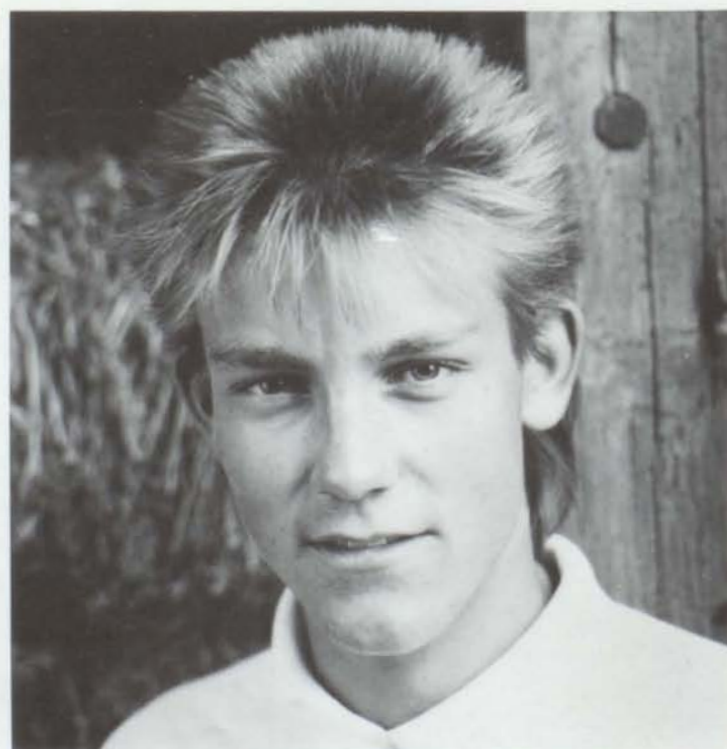

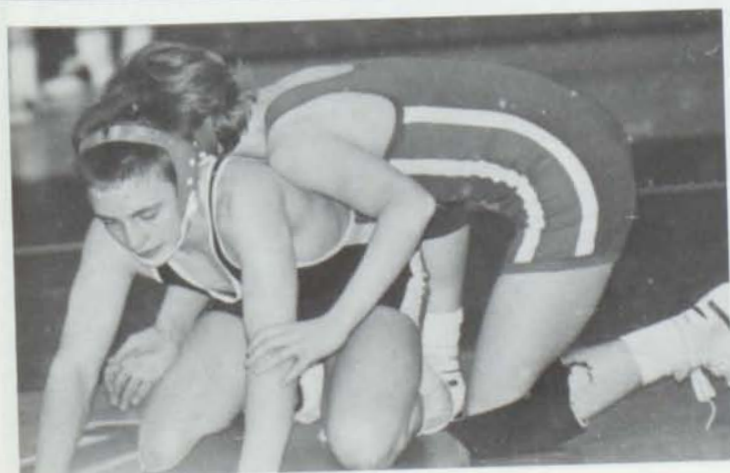
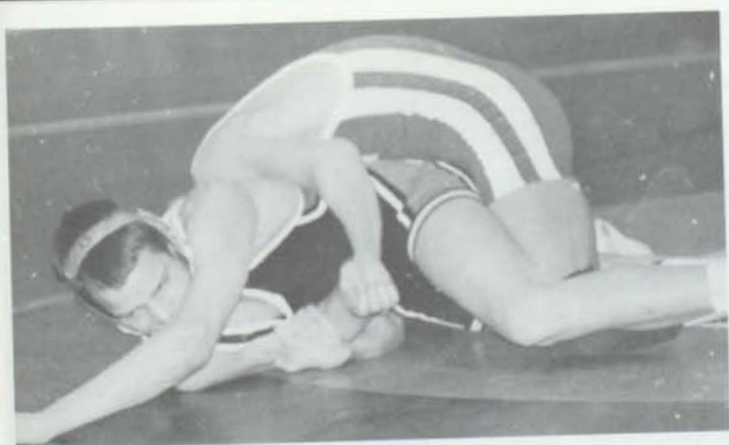

TIGERS CAPTURE FIRST SECTIONAL TITLE

The 1986 Varsity Soccer Season was like a roller coaster. During the regular season the Tigers never won more than three in a row, allowed five goals or more on three different occasions (each time bouncing back with a win or tie in their next game) and saw overtime in at least every fourth game. In addition, the 13-9-1 season saw the Tigers being handed their most defeats in the season since 1981 — AND YET the season turned out to coincide with the Chinese calendar as 'THE YEAR OF THE TIGER'!

Four of the Varsity booters' first five games were in tournament play — The Tigers defeated Canton in the Canton Tournament by a 1-0 score to take the third place trophy and then the following weekend dropped the title game in the Medina Tournament to Medina by a 2-1 margin. From that point on the Orange and Black primarily set their sights on their division and on October 9th the Tigers clinched their first Genesee Region Division Championship with a 5-1 victory over Pembroke.

A week later the boys' focus of attention became the Sectionals. Having won on their first Sectional game ever in 1985, the Tigers were looking to do better in 1986 — AND DID THEY EVER!! Sectional play opened with a 2-1 over-time win at home over Pavilion. Dave Donald scored the winner on a penalty kick. Alfred-Almond, who had eliminated Lyndonville in each of the two previous years, was next. A goal by Dan Soder early in the game and the first Sectional shutout by the Orange and Black, recorded by Kent Fischer, were all the Tigers needed to reach the finals for the first time. The title game saw Lyndonville defeat Belfast 2-0 for the Section 5, Class D-1 Sectional Title. Derek Dix, who scored both goals, was named Outstanding Offensive Player of the Game and Neil Hungerford was named Outstanding Defensive Player of the Game.

The Orange and Black next had to face Richburg to determine the overall Section 5, Class D Champion who would represent the Section in the New York State Playoffs. A goal by Jeff Dix following a length of the field effort with less than four minutes to play lifted the Tigers to a dramatic 2-1 victory — and the team became the first team in the history of Lyndonville athletics to qualify for the State Playoffs!!

The State Quarterfinal match vs. North Collins unfortunately ended with the Tigers on the short end of a 5-1 score after leading 1-0, but history had still been made. The crowd support at that game was phenomenal and showed nothing but pride in a bunch of young men who had turned one of the most difficult seasons in the team's history into the most successful ever. Congratulations to each and every one of you for the absolutely tremendous accomplishments.
