I spent this past summer in Ireland through AFS.
The program I was in was unlike any other student's we've sent abroad. I was on a work-study program. I stayed with a family in July and worked at a castle in August.
I stayed with the Armstrong's, a farming family in Redcross, Wicklow. I had a lot of free time but I helped milk the cows and helped out around the farm. It was something new to me.
The place where I worked was Birr Castle in Offaly. I stayed with two other AFS'ers in the servants quarters of the castle. It was a small apartment with a bathroom, three rooms and a kitchen. We were on our own to cook, and pick up after ourselves. We had no curfews and had the freedom to do as we like.

We worked as horticulturalists during the day and went out at night. The work we did was weeding plants, digging potatoes and other odd jobs. It was somewhat boring but it made our days pass by faster so we could go out at night.

Our stay at the castle was the most fun because we met a lot of people our own age and we had freedom. We all learned to live on our own.

Ireland was a beautiful place to be and the people were great. I can't wait to go back. I recommend everyone to go abroad through AFS and experience a different culture. It's something you'll never forget!
