

Lyndonville Lions Club July 4th Celebration 2023 Parade Information

The Lyndonville Lions Club will sponsor the Annual Independence Day Celebration on Tuesday, July 4, 2023. We would like to extend an invitation to you and your group to participate in our annual parade

All participants must register to participate in the parade. Registration deadline is **Friday**, **June 23**, **2023**.

The parade will begin promptly at **Noon**. All parade units are asked to meet at the intersection of Alps Road and Platten Road by **11:15 am**.

Directions to Staging Area:

After 11:00 am: Maple Ave. will be ONE WAY ONLY into the village.

All Vehicles: Take Rt. 63 to East Yates Center Road.

Turn right onto East Yates Center Road.

Turn right onto Blood Road.

Turn right onto Alps Road. Arrive at staging area.

NOTICE: Alps Rd. from Platten Rd. to Blood Rd. will be available to Local Traffic and Parade Participants **ONLY**.

All registered parade participants will receive more detailed information towards the end of June.



Lyndonville Lions Club July 4th Celebration 2023 Parade Rules and Regulations

The Lyndonville Lions 4th of July Parade is intended to be a patriotic display honoring the Country's Independence and the Veterans who fought to protect us. These regulations were developed to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for both the participants and spectators.

- 1. All entries in the parade must complete a parade application.
- 2. All applications must be received by **Friday**, **June 23**, **2023**.
- 3. Handing out of candy or objects is permitted by walkers only. Throwing of candy or objects from floats or vehicles is PROHIBITED.
- 4. Absolutely no paper handouts such as brochures, coupons and/or flyers can be distributed during the parade.
- 5. Organizations with children marching or riding on a vehicle must have a minimum of one (1) adult chaperone per ten (10) children.
- 6. The drinking, display, or consumption of alcoholic beverages and other intoxicants or controlled substances is absolutely prohibited.
- 7. HELMETS ARE REQUIRED for all riders of bicycles, skateboards, in-line skates, scooters, motorcycles, etc. regardless of age.
- 8. Participants with horses or other animals are required to have personnel available to clean-up animal waste dropped during the parade.
- 9. All floats, signage and apparel will be reviewed for appropriateness of content. Parade Marshalls have the right to reject any entries that do not reflect our family-friendly policy.
- 10. Entries may not include any images or content that includes nudity, profanity, lewdness, illegal drugs, violence, obscenity, hate, racism or that is vulgar, sexually explicit, insulting or offensive to any individual or group as determined by the Parade Marshalls.
- 11. The use of sirens is restricted between Eagle Street and the Main Street Bridge.
- 12. Parade participants must follow the requests of the Parade Marshalls.

The Lyndonville Lions Club reserves the right to prohibit any entry into the parade that does not comply with these rules and regulations.
